Petitioner is a wholly-owned operating subsidiary of Magna5 Holdings LLC. Petitioner has no affiliates offering and/or providing telecommunications services in the State of Louisiana.

Copies of Petitioner's Interexchange Tariff and Illustrative Local Exchange Tariff, including the terms of service are attached hereto as **Exhibit C**.

VII.

Petitioner is financially able to provide the services proposed in its tariff as evidenced by its 2018 and 2019 unaudited financial statements, marked and filed as "Confidential", a copy of which is attached in a separately sealed envelope.

VIII.

Petitioner seeks authority to resell and provide local exchange, interexchange, and voice-over internet protocol services throughout the State primarily in the areas served by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Louisiana. Petitioner's calling areas initially will coincide with the incumbent local exchange carrier's local calling areas. Petitioner has no current plans to install facilities in the State of Louisiana for the provision of local exchange services.

Upon initiation of service, Petitioner proposes to offer local, interexchange, and voiceover internet protocol services. Such services will be provided utilizing the facilities incumbent local exchange carriers ("LECs"). Petitioner seeks authority to provide all forms of intrastate local exchange telecommunications services including:

1. Local Exchange:

- A. Local Exchange Services that will enable customers to originate and terminate local calls in the local calling area served by other LECs, including local dial-tone and custom calling features.
- B. Switched local exchange services such as flat-rated local services; vertical services, Direct Inward and Outward Dialed trunks, and any other switched local services that currently exist or will exist in the future.

- C. Non-switched local services (*e.g.*, private line) that currently exist or will exist in the future.
- D. Centrex and/or Centrex-like services that currently exist or will exist in the future.
- E. Digital subscriber line, ISDN, and other high-capacity line services.

Magna5's services will be available on a full-time basis, twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week, to customers within the geographic boundaries of the State of Louisiana. Customers will be billed by Magna5.

IX.

Petitioner possesses the experience to support the services to be offered as set forth in the resumes of its key management personnel, which are attached hereto as <u>Exhibit E</u>.

Petitioner is currently authorized to provide local exchange services in California, Colorado, Connecticut, District of Columbia, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Massachusetts, Maryland, Maine, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, North Dakota, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Nevada, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Vermont, Washington, Wisconsin, and West Virginia. Petitioner has not been denied authority for any of the services for which it seeks authority in this Petition.

Petitioner submits the following arguments to demonstrate that the public interest will be served by the approval of this Petition:

The telecommunications industry is growing and changing at a rapid pace. The entry of Magna5 into the local exchange markets will enhance competition in the provision of telecommunications services within the State of Louisiana as prescribed by Commission policies and the Federal Act. Magna5 will bring significant benefits to telecommunications users in the State of Louisiana. Petitioner's expertise in the telecommunications sector will permit it to select the most economic and efficient services, thereby providing customers with a better combination of price, quality, and customer service than other carriers. Accordingly, Petitioner anticipates its proposed service will provide subscribers with better quality services and will increase consumer choice of innovative, diversified, and reliable service offerings. Petitioner asserts that the granting of the authority requested herein is in the public interest because expanded competition will reduce costs, increase business efficiencies and productivity, stimulate technological innovation, and increase the range, variety, and utility of services offered to end users.
