Re: Docket No. S-37700, Section 301(M) Notice of indirect transfer of control of Cox Enterprises, and its subsidiaries Cox Louisiana Telecom and Cox Wireless, from Cox to Charter Communications; Section 301(M) Notice of Cox Enterprises acquiring indirect ownership interest in Charter's Commission-regulated subsidiaries, including Charter Fiberlink and Spectrum Mobile, LLC; and for related financing.

Dear Counsels:

After review of the record, the Louisiana Public Service Commission Staff ("Staff") states that the following actions have occurred in the above-referenced docket:

- (1) The application submitted by Charter Communications, Inc. ("Charter"), Cox Enterprises, Inc. ("CEP"), and Cox Communications, Inc. ("Cox") (collectively, the "Parties") on August 7,

2025 to provide notice of a proposed transaction (the “Transaction”) that will result in (1) the indirect transfer of control of Cox and its subsidiaries, including Cox Louisiana Telecom, L.L.C and Cox Wireless, LLC (the “Cox Licensees”), from CEI to Charter, and (2) CEI acquiring an indirect, minority ownership interest in Charter’s Commission-regulated Louisiana subsidiaries, including Charter Fiberlink LA-CCO, LLC and Spectrum Mobile, LLC (the “Charter Licensees”); and may result in (3) the Cox Licensees (but not the Charter Licensees) providing support for certain financing arrangements in connection with the Transaction.

- (2) Notice of the filing was published in the Commission’s Official Bulletin No. 1356 on August 15, 2025.
- (3) The fifteen (15) day intervention period in this docket expired without intervention or protest on September 1, 2025.
- (4) Staff detected no compliance issues involving the parties to the proposed transaction.

This letter is to acknowledge that Staff has reviewed the above-docketed matter. Additionally, at present there are no outstanding compliance issues involving the Company. Therefore, pursuant to Section 301(M)(1) of the Louisiana Public Service Commission’s Regulations for Competition in the Local Telecommunications Market (Attachment A to General Order No. R-31839 dated March 11, 2014), this request is deemed **approved** without further action by the Louisiana Public Service Commission, and the above-docketed matter will be closed.
