A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY IS HEREBY GRANTED TO **FDF ENERGY SERVICES, LLC** whose office or place of business is at **CROWLEY, LOUISIANA** authorizing operations in Louisiana intrastate commerce as a COMMON CARRIER OF SPECIAL COMMODITIES OVER IRREGULAR ROUTES by motor, handling the following described commodities, in territories described:

Transportation of:

- (1) liquid mud and treated fluids utilized in the discovery, development, drilling, completion, maintenance, and production of oil, gas and other petroleum products to and from Francis Drilling Fluids, Ltd. Storage facilities to and from all points in Louisiana;
- (2) liquid mud and fluids utilized in the discovery, development, drilling, completion, maintenance, and production of oil, gas and other petroleum products, not which are not re-useable and are considered disposable, from all locations within the State which have been serviced by Francis Drilling Fluids, Ltd. Within 30 days of the request for the transportation services to all points in Louisiana.

Restricted against transportation of dry bulk materials in pneumatic tank trucks.

(Reissued pursuant to S-35098 for ownership & name change to Francis Energy Services, LLC previously issued pursuant to Order Nos. S-34705 and T-15379 dated July 27, 1982 and L.R.S. 45:164 and the rules and regulations of the Louisiana Public Service Commission. Except for cause beyond control, non-operation of an authority for a period of six (6) months could lead to its cancellation pursuant to La. R.S. 45:166, Paragraphs B and C).

Said **FDF ENERGY SERVICES, LLC** shall perform such operations under prescribed rates or tariffs now or hereafter filed with the Commission and in compliance with all laws and rules and regulations of the Commission bearing thereon.
