**LOUISIANA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

SCOTT MOVING CO AKA SCOTT MOVERS
(SCOTT, LOUISIANA), EX PARTE**

In re: Alleged violation of La. R.S. 45:161 through 180.1, by engaging in activities related to moving household goods prior to complying with the requirements of La. R.S. 45:164 (E) and General Order dated May 04, 2017 and for failure to comply with the requirements of General Order dated April 3, 2008 as amended.

REPORT OF STATUS CONFERENCE

A telephonic status conference was convened in this proceeding on November 2, 2020, before Chief Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) Melanie Verzwylvelt. Participating in the status conference were:

Joseph McMahon, on behalf of Scott Moving Co AKA Scott Movers (“Carrier”); and

Justin Bello and Tammy Burl, on behalf of the Louisiana Public Service Commission (“Commission”) Staff.

Mr. Bello stated that the Commission Staff and the Carrier need additional time to reach a resolution in this matter, and requested a hearing date. Mr. McMahon was reminded that he should formally enroll as counsel. The parties then agreed to a procedural schedule. Accordingly,

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the following procedural schedule is hereby established:

November 18, 2020 Discovery deadline (all discovery to be completed by this date).

December 2, 2020 Deadline for filing of Joint Pre-Hearing Statement, setting forth:

1. An agreed upon proposed order of witnesses;
2. A list of uncontested issues agreed upon by the parties; and
3. A list of contested issues.

December 2, 2020

Deadline for filing of Pre-Hearing Briefs. The parties' briefs shall address, in the order presented in the Joint Pre-Hearing Statement, the remaining issues in dispute.

December 9, 2020

Hearing. A hearing in this matter will be convened at **2:00 PM on Wednesday, December 9, 2020** in the 11th Floor Hearing Room of the Galvez Building, 602 North Fifth Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

All parties intending to present evidence at the hearing shall bring a copy of each exhibit for the court reporter, as well as additional copies for the judge, the research attorney, and all other parties to the proceeding. Hearing exhibits presented to the court reporter for admission into the hearing record shall be single-sided.

Any party seeking a continuance of the hearing date must file a motion for the continuance by **December 2, 2020**. The motion must also contain a statement (1) affirming that the moving party has contacted all other parties to the case concerning the proposed continuance and (2) advising of the position of each of the other parties to the proposed continuance. Motions for continuance filed after this date will be considered only upon a showing of good cause for the delay.

If you are disabled and require special accommodation at the hearing, please contact the Administrative Hearings Division at (225) 219-9417 at least five days prior to the date of the hearing. A public parking lot is located on North Street, across from the Galvez Building.

PLEASE NOTE that as of the time of this status conference, the Office of State Buildings requires that all visitors to the Galvez Building submit to a temperature check. Only those with temperature below 100.4 degrees will be allowed to enter the building. In addition, all visitors are required to wear face coverings. Parties shall stay informed of these requirements and adhere to them when attending in-person meetings and hearings.
