YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED, COMMANDED AND REQUIRED to appear at a hearing on Tuesday, February 3, 2026 at 9:30 a.m., before a Louisiana Public Service Commission Administrative Law Judge. The hearing will be held at the Louisiana Public Service Commission, Galvez Building, 11th Floor, 602 North 5th Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, 70802. Parking is available in the Galvez Parking Garage across from the Galvez Building on North Street. **Furthermore, a citation fee in the amount of \$25.00 has been assessed to your LPSC account.**

TO SHOW CAUSE, if any you have or can, why an order should not be issued by the Commission canceling your **Common Carrier Certificate Nos. 7011 & 7127** for failure to maintain the required insurance coverage on file with the Commission pursuant to General Order dated October 13, 2023 and for further order or orders as the Commission may deem necessary in the premises.

At the hearing, the Commission Staff will present testimony and evidence in support of its allegations against you. You will be provided an opportunity to cross-examine the Commission Staff's witness(es) and to present evidence and testimony in your defense. RE: Insurance

Your **Common Carrier Certificate Nos. 7011 & 7127** has been flagged for failure to maintain the required insurance coverage on file with the Commission. In accordance with the Commission's General Order dated October 13, 2023, intrastate carriers must maintain proof of the required insurance coverage on file at the Commission at all times. Should the carrier fail to maintain such filings, the Commission may pursuant to La. R.S. 45:166, revoke the carrier's certificate.

- On September 4, 2025 the Commission received a Form K showing a cancellation date of October 3, 2025 for your Commercial Auto Liability Insurance. A letter was mailed to your company on October 10, 2025, requesting a new Form E filing. As of the date of this letter, a **new Form E for Commercial Auto Liability Insurance** has not yet been received.

You have tentatively been scheduled to appear at a hearing on Tuesday, February 3, 2026 at 9:30 a.m., before a Louisiana Public Service Commission Administrative Law Judge to show cause why an order should not be issued by the Commission canceling your **Common Carrier Certificate Nos. 7011 & 7127** for failure to maintain the required insurance coverage on file with the Commission; and for further order or orders as the Commission may deem necessary in the premises.

If the required insurance coverage is not received by **December 1, 2025**, the Commission will proceed to issue a citation where Commission Staff will present testimony and evidence in support of its allegations against you. Once your company is cited a **TWENTY FIVE DOLLAR (\$25.00)** citation fee will be assessed. If you have any questions regarding this matter, please contact our office at (225) 342-1424.


