SUBMISSION OF PROOFS OF PUBLICATION

NOW BEFORE the Louisiana Public Service Commission (“**Commission**” or “**LPSC**”), through undersigned counsel, comes Utilities, Inc. of Louisiana (“**UIL**”), who avers as follows:

1.

UIL, a Louisiana corporation, is a for-profit public utility providing safe and reliable water and wastewater service in the following parishes in Louisiana: Ascension, Assumption, Bienville, Calcasieu, East Baton Rouge, Evangeline, Jackson, Livingston, Madison, Morehouse, Richland, St. Landry, St. Tammany, Tangipahoa, Vermilion, Washington, West Baton Rouge, West Feliciana, and Winn.

2.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Louisiana Constitution, Article IV, Section 21, when a public utility files a proposed rate schedule that would result in a change in rates, it is required to give notice of such application by publication in the official state journal and in the official journal of each parish within the geographic area in which the schedule would become applicable.

3.

On May 23, 2023, in accordance with the requirements of LPSC Order No. U-36003, UIL filed a Formula Rate Plan Annual Report (“**Annual Report**”) with the Commission, which is based on the test year ending on December 31, 2022 and was calculated in accordance with the

appropriate Formula Rate Plan Rider Schedule. Under the Formula Rate Plan approved by the LPSC in Docket No. U-36003, UIL's water and wastewater rates should be increased.

4.

After the filing of the Annual Report, UIL caused to be published in the official journals of each of the parishes described above and in the official state journal the notice of filing of the Annual Report and the rate increase.
