SPECIAL ORDER NO. 32-2026 - 4/14/2026 - 2026 Utility Special Orders. This Special Order ratifies LPSC interventions in Federal Energy Regulatory Proceedings regarding Regional Transmission Organization issues or Entergy Regional State Committee issues. This matter was voted on at the Commission's March 18, 2026 Business and Executive Session.

ORDER NO. R-37773 - 4/14/2026 - Louisiana Public Service Commission, ex parte. In re: Vegetation Management Pilot Program Order No. 04-15-2026 (R-37773) approves a Vegetation Management Pilot Program for jurisdictional electric utilities. This matter was voted on at the Commission's March 18, 2026 Business and Executive Session.

ORDER NO. U-37343 - 4/22/2026 - Dixie Electric Membership Corporation, ex parte. In re: Request for a rate rider to recover costs associated with the Move Ascension Road Projects. Order No. U-37343 dismisses this matter.

ORDER NO. U-37394 - 4/17/2026 - South Louisiana Electric Cooperative Association, ex parte. In re: Petition for approval of abandonment of electric facilities located in Terrebonne and Lafourche Parishes pursuant to Commission General Order dated July 9, 2008 (R-30301). Order No. U-37394 accepts in part and rejects in part the Proposed Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge filed into the record of this matter on February 27, 2026, thereby granting SLECA's request to abandon the Lake De Cade segment of the Lake Lines, finding that SLECA has not met its burden of proof regarding the Lake Fields, Four Point, and Grand Pass segments of the Lake Lines, and remanding the matter back to the Administrative Law Judge for additional proceedings regarding the three remaining segments. The vote occurred at the Commission's March 18, 2026 Business and Executive Session.

ORDER NO. U-37595 - 4/17/2026 - Entergy Louisiana, LLC, ex parte. In re: Request for approval of Demand Response Programs, including cost recovery. Order No. U-37595 approves the Uncontested Stipulated Settlement filed into the record on February 9, 2026, thereby authorizing Entergy Louisiana, LLC to implement the requested demand response programs, subject to certain conditions.
