REPORT OF STATUS CONFERENCE

A status conference was convened in this proceeding on September 4, 2024, before Administrative Law Judge Melissa Frey. Participating in the status conference were:

Jane Ann Anzalone and Jonathan Brown, both telephonically, on behalf of GDE Tiger Drilling LLC (“Applicant”); and

Paul Rachal and Tammy Burl on behalf of the Louisiana Public Service Commission (“Commission”) Staff.

Mr. Brown provided an overview of the Applicant’s operations, confirmed the authority requested in the Application, and stated the reasons the Applicant is seeking the requested authority. Mr. Rachal advised the Tribunal that discovery is complete. The parties then discussed and agreed to a procedural schedule. Accordingly,

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the following procedural schedule is established:

September 25, 2024 Filing deadline for Commission Staff to file notice of any complaint, citation, or violation pending against the Applicant. And,

Filing deadline for Applicant and Commission Staff to file Pre-Hearing Statements, including the following:

- (1) List of exhibits;
- (2) List of witnesses (with witness’ name, title, employer, and a brief description of the subject matter upon which each witness will testify); and
- (3) If the hearing is contested, a list of any contested issues.

October 2, 2024 **Hearing.** A hearing in this matter will be convened at **10:00 A.M. on Wednesday October 2, 2024**, in the 11th Floor Hearing Room of the Galvez Building, 602 North Fifth Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana.


All parties intending to present evidence at the hearing shall bring a copy of each exhibit for the court reporter, as well as additional copies for the judge, the research attorney, and all other parties to the proceeding. Hearing exhibits presented to the court reporter for admission into the hearing record shall be single-sided.

Any party seeking a continuance of the hearing date must file a motion for the continuance by **September 25, 2024**. The motion must also contain a statement (1) affirming that the moving party has contacted all other parties to the case concerning the proposed continuance and (2) advising of the position of each of the other parties to the proposed continuance. Motions for continuance filed after this date will be considered only upon a showing of good cause for the delay.

If you require special accommodation at the hearing, please contact the Administrative Hearings Division at (225) 219-9417 at least five days prior to the date of the hearing.

Public parking is available in the Galvez Garage across North Street from the Galvez Building. The Office of State Buildings uses a gateless license plate reader in the Galvez Garage. Visitors should take a picture of their license plate as they will be required to provide detailed vehicle information within thirty minutes of entry into the parking garage. Further instruction will be provided upon arrival at the Commission.
