



BEFORE THE HONORABLE COMMISSION, comes Louisiana Generating LLC (“La-Gen”), Big Cajun II Unit 4 LLC (“BCII-4”), NRG Bayou Cove Peaking Power LLC (“Bayou Cove”), Big Cajun I Peaking Power LLC (“Big Cajun I”), NRG Sterlington Power, LLC (“Sterlington”) and NRG Power Marketing LLC. (“Power Marketing”) (collectively “NRG” or the “NRG Companies), parties in interest, which, through undersigned counsel, respectfully move the Honorable Commission to grant this Petition for Late Intervention so as allow NRG to participate in the proceedings and to be placed on the service list.

1.

The Louisiana Public Service Commission (“LPSC”) initiated this proceeding to study the possible development of financial incentives for the promotion of energy efficiency by jurisdictional electric and gas utilities. Notice of this proceeding was published in the LPSC’s Official Bulletin Number 938, dated August 7, 2009. The deadline for submitting Interventions was September 1, 2009.

2.

The NRG Companies are wholly-owned subsidiaries of NRG Energy, Inc. Bayou Cove, Big Cajun I, La-Gen, and Sterlington own approximately 2400 MW of generation facilities in Louisiana. La-Gen generates and sells electricity at wholesale to, among others, ten rural electric

cooperatives in Louisiana. Power Marketing is a power marketer that also engages in wholesale transactions in the region.

3.

Rule 10 of the LPSC's Rules of Practice and Procedure provides that any party with an actual interest may appear in a proceeding before the LPSC. For the reasons set forth above, NRG has a direct and substantial interest in the issues involved in this proceeding, which cannot be adequately represented by any other party.

Because no formal action has been taken by LPSC Staff in this docket, allowing NRG to participate as a full intervenor in this proceeding will have no detrimental effect on Staff, or any other party to this proceeding.


