In order to obtain a certificate or to amend a certificate to haul waste applicants have the burden of providing proof of their fitness to operate by satisfying the requirements set forth in General Order dated January 23, 2018. You will be required to show fitness at a hearing, through the testimony of witnesses and the presentation of evidence. At the hearing, you will also have to prove that your client has complied with or has the ability to comply with all regulation requirements of the Louisiana Public Service Commission.

The Administrative Hearings Division will notify you concerning the assignment of this matter to an Administrative Law Judge and the scheduling of a preliminary status conference and hearing.
