Re: Docket No. S-36012 CenturyLink of Louisiana, LLC and Comcast Phone of Louisiana, LLC d/b/a Comcast Digital Phone. In re: Request for Approval of an Amendment Pursuant to Sections 251 and 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

Dear Ms. Villa:

Pursuant to Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the "Act"), the Louisiana Public Service Commission ("Commission") notifies CenturyLink of Louisiana ("CenturyLink") and Comcast Phone of Louisiana, LLC d/b/a Comcast Digital Phone ("Comcast") of the following:

1. On May 12, 2021, the Commission received a Request for Approval of an Agreement between the above-referenced entities pursuant to Sections 251 and 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. The request was published in the Commission's Official Bulletin dated June 11, 2021.
2. The twenty-five (25) day period for intervention expired with no intervention or opposition being received by the Commission.
3. As noted in your request, Section 252(e) of the Act requires that the Commission approve or reject an Agreement within ninety (90) days of its submission.
4. Pursuant to Section 252(e):
 - a. The Commission has not found that the agreement discriminates against a

telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement.

- b. The Commission has not found that the agreement is inconsistent with the public interest, convenience or necessity.

Accordingly, the request for approval of the agreement between AT&T Louisiana and CLEC, pursuant to Sections 251 and 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, is **deemed approved**. This letter closes the docket and no further action will be taken
