The Advanced Energy Management Alliance (“AEMA”), pursuant to Rule 10 of the Louisiana Public Service Commission (“LPSC” or “Commission”) Rules of Practices and Procedures, respectively submits this Notice of Intervention in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of this notice, AEMA represents the following:

1.

Notice of this proceeding was published in the LPSC’s Official Bulletin Number 1188, dated March 8, 2019. Interventions are due on or before April 2, 2019.

2.

AEMA is a trade association under Section 501(c)(6) of the Federal tax code whose members include national distributed energy resource (“DER”) companies and advanced energy management service and technology providers, including demand response (“DR”) providers, as

well as some of the nation's largest demand response and distributed energy resources. AEMA member companies have delivered approximately 20,000 MW of sophisticated, cost-effective DR solutions. AEMA member companies have worked with utilities on DR programs across the southern United States, the Midcontinent Independent System Operation ("MISO") region, and the entire country, and have extensive experience working to align utility and ratepayer needs through proceedings before state regulatory Commissions.

Rule 10 of the LPSC Rules of Practice and Procedures provides that any party actually in interest may appear in any proceeding before the LPSC.

AEMA has an interest in working with parties throughout Louisiana to create and expand DR and DER opportunities as a means to achieve electricity cost savings for consumers, contribute to system reliability and resilience, and avoid new capacity investments. Further, AEMA has an interest in exploring solutions directly with utilities to expand DR and DER opportunities to their customers through utility tariffs, as opposed to enrolling customers directly in the wholesale market without utility engagement.

No other party to this proceeding is suited to adequately represent AEMA's interests and this intervention will not prejudice any other party or unduly delay these proceedings.
