Application for approval of generation and transmission resources in connection with service to a single customer for a project in North Louisiana.

PETITION OF INTERVENTION

NOW BEFORE the Louisiana Public Service Commission (the “Commission” or “LPSC”), through undersigned counsel, comes 1803 Electric Cooperative, Inc. (“1803”), who intervenes in the above captioned docket and respectfully provides the following notice:

1.

1803 was incorporated in 2019 as a Louisiana electric cooperative organized pursuant to La. R.S. 12:401 et seq., is regulated by the LPSC, and includes as its members multiple Louisiana electric cooperatives, who are also LPSC-regulated. 1803 will begin providing wholesale power and/or transmission services to its member cooperatives in 2025.

2.

The Commission issued a published notice of this proceeding the above-captioned docket in the Commission’s Official Bulletin No. 1336, on November 8, 2024. The proceeding has been described as a docket for Entergy Louisiana, LLC (“ELL”)’s application for approval of generation and transmission resources in connection with service to a single customer for a project in North Louisiana. In this Application, ELL is seeking, amongst other things, the approval of generation and transmission resources for a large facility to be located in Richland Parish, Louisiana, which is described to include three new Combined Cycle Combustion Turbine (“CCCT”) generators, two

of which would be next to the customer’s selected site in Holly Ridge, Louisiana; a new 500 kV transmission line extending from a substation near Sarepta, Louisiana to a substation near Mt. Olive, Louisiana; and certain equipment upgrades at the 500 kV substation near Sterlington, Louisiana.

As an LPSC-regulated electric utility and a wholesale power generation and transmission cooperative, 1803 has an interest in this proceeding and is a permitted intervenor under Rule 10 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure.

The deadline for filing interventions in this matter is set at ten (10) days from the date of the LPSC’s Official Bulletin No. 1336, or by November 18, 2024, as computed in accordance with the LPSC’s Rules of Practice and Procedure. Therefore, 1803’s intervention is timely.
