Re: LPSC Docket No. S-37593; Acme Truck Line, Inc., ex parte. In re: Application to approve changes in ownership greater than 50% for Common Carrier Certificate Nos. 5268-E & 5826-G pursuant to General Order dated October 08, 2019.

Dear Mr. Falgout:

Acme Truck Line, Inc. ("Acme Truck") submitted an application to the Louisiana Public Service Commission ("Commission") requesting a letter of non-opposition to approve changes in ownership greater than 50% for Common Carrier Certificate Nos. 5268-E & 5826-G pursuant to General Order dated October 08, 2019. This application, with its attachments, was received by the Commission on May 13, 2025, and was subsequently published in the Commission's Official Bulletin #1350 dated May 23, 2025 with a publication period of fifteen (15) days. No interventions or protests were received by the Commission during this publication period.

Acme Truck currently holds Common Carrier Certificate Nos. 5268-E & 5826-G, which allows for the transportation of non-hazardous oilfield waste, non-hazardous industrial solid waste, and hazardous waste, as well as the transportation of salt water utilized in oil well exploration and production for disposal by motor vehicle statewide.

Acme Truck is a Louisiana Limited Liability Company, in good standing and is qualified to do business in the State of Louisiana. Ownership of Acme Truck is currently listed with the Commission as Michael Coatney owning 78.5%, and Acme Truck Line Employee Stock Ownership Plan ("ESOP") owning 21.5%. Acme Truck has acknowledged this application was filed after the change in ownership but sufficiently provided good faith evidence of the reason for the change in ownership prior to


Commission approval. According to two Board Resolution dated March 5, 2024 and December 18, 2024, shares of Acme Truck were to be transferred from Michael Coatney to Tyler Coatney, Erin Coatney Hernandez, and Laura Coatney, individually, on March 11, 2024 and December 20, 2024, respectively. According to the minutes of a Special Meeting of Directors of Acme Truck dated December 26, 2024 shares of Acme Truck were redeemed by Acme Truck and then contributed to Acme Truck Line ESOP. The resulting ownership structure of Acme Truck is as follows:

Michael Coatney:	25.5%
Tyler Coatney:	17%
Laura Coatney:	17%
Erin Coatney Hernandez:	17%
Acme Truck Line ESOP:	23.5%

Based on the factual assertions in your application, as well as the documents submitted to Commission Staff, the change in ownership at issue in this docket is in the public interest. Acme Truck has sufficiently provided evidence of good faith in failing to obtain prior approval of the change in ownership by submitting the Acme Truck Line, Inc. Board Resolutions and statement explaining the reason for the failure pursuant to LPSC General Order dated October 8, 2019 (R-35298). As such, the Commission states its non-opposition to the change of ownership of Common Carrier Certificate Nos. 5268-E & 5826-G. Acme Truck has further confirmed its understanding of the Commission's rules for regulated common carriers by motor vehicle when utilizing owner/operators under lease pursuant to General Order 9901 (3rd Amended) dated July 09, 1984. Further, the approval of the change of ownership is conditioned upon Acme Truck's continued full compliance with the laws of the State of Louisiana and the rules and regulations of the Commission.

This statement of non-opposition is made without prejudice to the authority of the Commission to make investigations and require any reasonably necessary action it may legally find to be in the public interest.
