

STATEMENT OF OBJECTION


The Louisiana Energy Users Group (“LEUG”) submits this filing in the referenced docket as a statement of preliminary objection to Entergy’s application filing for the West Bank Transmission Project. Pursuant to the LPSC General Certification Order R-26018 pertaining to transmission projects, Staff and Intervenors are required to file a statement within 45 days of publication of an application filing to identify whether they will have any objections to the application, and in the event of any objections then further proceedings will be had to consider the project. The required statements are due on May 6, 2024 (45 days from publication on March 22, 2024).<sup>1</sup>

LEUG does not know at this time if it will ultimately agree to or have any opposition to the proposed project. LEUG is currently reviewing the filing and anticipates it will need to pursue discovery in order that it can complete its evaluation of the project. Thus, at this time, LEUG submits this statement identifying a preliminary objection to the filing.


