BEFORE THE HONORABLE COMMISSION, comes Southwestern Electric Power Company ("SWEPCO"), an electric public utility serving Louisiana ratepayers and party in interest, who respectively submits this Notice of Intervention in the captioned proceeding pursuant to Rule 10 of the Louisiana Public Service Commission ("Commission") Rules of Practices and Procedures as follows:

1.

SWEPCO is an electric public utility owning and operating electricity generation, transmission and distribution facilities in Louisiana, Arkansas and Texas, and provides electric service to Louisiana ratepayers subject to the authority of the Commission.

The Commission initiated this docket to review rules regarding electric utility billing. The Commission published notice of this docket in Official Bulletin #1188, dated

March 8, 2019. Interventions are permitted within 25 days of the date of the publication. Therefore, this intervention is timely.

Rule 10 of the LPSC Rules of Practice and Procedure provides that any party actually in interest may appear in a proceeding before the LPSC when intervening timely.

SWEPCO is an electric public utility serving ratepayers throughout Northwest and Central Louisiana. Any recommendations, rulings, decisions, regulations or Orders adopted by the Commission in this docket may impact the business and operations of SWEPCO in this State. Therefore, SWEPCO has a justiciable and administratively cognizable interest in this proceeding and is a party in interest.

SWEPCO wishes to participate in this docket as an intervenor as no other party can adequately represent SWEPCO's interest in the captioned proceeding. This intervention will not prejudice any other party or unduly delay the proceedings.
