PETITION FOR INTERVENTION

NOW BEFORE THIS COMMISSION, through undersigned counsel, comes Entergy Louisiana, LLC (“ELL” or the “Company”), which, pursuant to Rule 10 of the Louisiana Public Service Commission’s (“LPSC” or the “Commission”) Rules of Practices and Procedures (“Rules”), respectfully submits this Petition for Intervention with respect to the above-captioned proceeding. In support, ELL represents the following:

I.

The notice of publication of this docket appeared in the Commission’s Official Bulletin No. 1356 dated August 15, 2025. Interventions must be filed within 15 days of the date of publication in the Commission’s Official Bulletin, or by September 2, 2025. This intervention is therefore timely.

II.

Pursuant to Rule 10 of the LPSC’s Rules, “[a]ny party actually in interest may appear in any proceeding before the” LPSC.

III.

The Company is a regulated utility that was organized for the purposes, among others, of developing, manufacturing, generating, transmitting, distributing, and selling electricity for power, lighting, heating, and other such uses. ELL conducts business in fifty-eight (58) of the sixty-four (64) parishes of the State of Louisiana.

IV.

In the Petition for Jurisdictional Determination, The Dow Chemical Company (“TDCC”) and Diamond Infrastructure Solutions (“Diamond”) request the LPSC to declare that the proposed “Facilities Lease, any other related agreement, the ownership, management, operation and maintenance, power transfers, and any and all interests whether arising from lease, mortgage, encumbrance, sublease or assignment” as to the referenced Plaquemine Facilities “will not cause the Parties in Interest—Proposed Lessee, Diamond, TDCC, or any shareholders of or investors in Proposed Lessee, Diamond, or TDCC, or lenders, other affiliates, or their respective successors or assigns—either individually or collectively” to be considered an “electric utility,” or “electric public utility,” or otherwise subject the referenced Plaquemine Facilities or the Parties in Interest to regulation by the Commission. A decision by the Commission in this matter requires interpreting statutes regarding the definition of a “public utility” and can affect broader interests throughout the state. ELL is interested in monitoring the progress of this matter to protect the interests of its customers.

V.


