RE: Section 301.M Notice of transaction for approval of an Agreement to Sell and/ Transfer the Certification for CLEC authority of Hunt Land Holdings, LLC to its subsidiary, CableSouth Media III, LLC.

Dear Mr. Frey:

Hunt Land Holdings, LLC (“Hunt Land” or “Transferor”) and its wholly-owned subsidiary, CableSouth Media III, LLC (“CableSouth” or “Transferee”) by and through undersigned counsel, hereby submit this letter providing notice to the Louisiana Public Service Commission (“Commission”) pursuant to Section 301.M of the Local Competition Regulations of a transaction in which, pursuant to an Asset Purchase Agreement executed of even date herewith, CableSouth will acquire Hunt Land’s Certificate of Authority to Operate as a Competitive Access and Competitive Local Exchange Provider in the State (“the Acquisition”). This CLEC certificate was originally issued by the Commission to Hunt Land in Docket No. S-36356 and Hunt Land was issued Certificate Number TSP733.

The transaction involves an entity licensed to provide telecommunications services to customers in Louisiana, which necessitated this filing. Because the transaction will be completely transparent to customers, there are no slamming issues involved. However, to the extent that the Commission deems necessary, the Parties hereby jointly request a waiver of the Commission’s slamming regulations.

The Parties propose a transaction whereby CableSouth will acquire Hunt Land Holdings, LLC’s license to provide Competitive Access and Competitive Local Exchange Services in the State. Upon consummation of the transaction, the license will transfer to CableSouth and the name of the license holder will be changed to CableSouth.

Hunt Land Holdings, LLC is a Louisiana limited liability company with principal offices located at 42068 Fire Tower Road, Ponchatoula, LA 70454. Hunt Land holds a Competitive Access and Competitive Local Exchange Provider license in the State, issued on November 4, 2019 in TSP733.

CableSouth Media III, LLC is a Tennessee limited liability company with principal offices located at 2090 S. First Street, Milan, Tennessee. CableSouth is licensed to provide Cable and Video Services in Louisiana. This license was issued by the Louisiana Secretary of State on November 17, 2008.

The proposed transaction will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity. Consummation of the proposed transaction will reduce costs and financially strengthen the company without altering its operations. Applicants emphasize that the transfer of Hunt's CLEC license will not change the rates, terms or conditions under which customers receive service.


The Commission's ability and authority to regulate Hunt Land and CableSouth and to ensure that it satisfies all obligations, commitments and regulatory requirements established by the laws of this state and the Commission will remain unchanged. Thus, there is no potential harm to the public interest raised by the proposed transaction and there will be clear benefits to the public upon the closing of this transaction.

For the reasons stated herein, the Applicants respectfully request that this Commission publish notice of this transaction in its next Official Bulletin pursuant to Section 301.M of the Local Competition Regulations, and grant all other relief as necessary and appropriate to effectuate the transaction described herein.
