SUBMISSION OF PROOFS OF PUBLICATION

NOW BEFORE the Louisiana Public Service Commission ("Commission" or "LPSC"), through undersigned counsel, comes Utilities, Inc. of Louisiana ("UIL"), who avers as follows:

1.

UIL, a Louisiana corporation, is a for-profit public utility providing safe and reliable water and wastewater service in the following parishes in Louisiana: Ascension, Assumption, Bienville, Calcasieu, East Baton Rouge, Evangeline, Jackson, Livingston, Madison, Morehouse, Richland, St. Landry, St. Tammany, Tangipahoa, Vermilion, Washington, West Baton Rouge, West Feliciana, and Winn.

2.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Louisiana Constitution, Article IV, Section 21, when a public utility files a proposed rate schedule that would result in a change in rates, it is required to give notice of such application by publication in the official state journal and in the official journal of each parish within the geographic area in which the schedule would become applicable.

On May 25, 2021, UIL filed a Request for Extension of Formula Rate Plan and Modification Thereto ("Request"), which could lead to a future change in rates as well as a future change in UIL's formula rate plan.

After the filing of the Request, UIL caused to be published in the official journals of each of the parishes described above and in the official state journal the notice of filing of the Request and the effects thereof.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a reference to this Resolution be noted on the face of the Official Minutes of the MPPJ meeting of June 14, 2021.


