

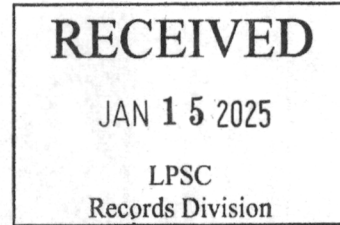

Re: *In Re: Application of Entergy Louisiana, LLC for Recovery in Rates of Costs Related to Hurricane Francine and for Related Relief (LPSC Docket No. U-37468)*

Dear Mr. Frey:

I am writing on behalf of Entergy Louisiana, LLC (“ELL” or “the Company”) to respectfully request that the Louisiana Public Service Commission (“LPSC” or “the Commission”) re-publish in its January 17, 2025 bulletin the notice of the filing of the Company’s Application for Recovery in Rates of Costs Related to Hurricane Francine and for Other Related Relief (the “Application”) and to correspondingly reset the intervention period for an additional fifteen-day period from the publication date.


ELL filed its Application on December 30, 2024, seeking, among other things, a finding from the Commission that the costs incurred by ELL in responding to, and restoring service following, Hurricane Francine were reasonable and necessary and, therefore, eligible for recovery from customers. Notice of the Company’s Application originally appeared in the Commission’s Official Bulletin #1340, which was published on January 3, 2025. With one exception, publication of notice of the Company’s filing is expected, within twenty days after the filing, to be made in the official state journal and in the official journal of each parish of the geographical area in which the proposed change would become applicable. Reportedly due to a technical issue experienced by the journal for Webster Parish, Louisiana, however, the notice is not expected to be published in Webster Parish until January 22, 2025, which is after the twenty-day period for publication.

Based on the foregoing, the Company requests that notice of the Company’s filing be republished in the Commission’s Official Bulletin to be published on January 17, 2025, in order that the Company may timely publish notice in the appropriate official state and parish journals. The Company further asks that the intervention period be reset for an additional fifteen days after publication in order that any additional interventions may be allowed.
