In cases where applications for the transfer of Transportation certificates and permits are unopposed after expiration of the publication period and the Staff is satisfied that the transferor has operated the authority pursuant to requirements of LRS 45:166b and that the transferee is ready, fit and able to operate the authority, the authority shall be transferred after expedited hearing and the appropriate filings being made. Likewise, uncontested applications for Transportation certificates and permits will also be approved after expedited hearing and the staff is satisfied that the record after hearing does reveal that a prima facie case of fitness has been shown.

R.S. 45:161 through 180.1, by engaging in activities related to moving household goods prior to complying with the requirements of La. R.S. 45:164 (E) and General Orders dated March 16, 2021 and April 3, 2008 as amended. Order No. T-37747 finds 2Easy2Move Moving Services, LLC guilty; orders 2Easy to pay a \$1,000 fine and \$25 citation fee within 30 days of the Order; and requires 2 Easy to cease all advertising for moving household goods intrastate and provide proof of such to the Commission, or obtain Commission authority to operate as an intrastate household goods mover within 30 days of the Order. Order No. T-37747 documents the Commission's vote at the April 15, 2026 Business and Executive Session adopting the ALJ Recommendation issued on March 9, 2026.

**ORDER NO. T-37748 - 4/30/2026** - Louisiana Public Service Commission vs. Nola Moving, LLC. In re: Alleged violation of 1) Order T-37118 and 2) Louisiana Revised Statutes 45:161 through 180.1 by engaging in activities related to moving household goods prior to complying with the requirements of La. R.S. 45:164 (E) and General Order dated March 16, 2021 and for failure to comply with the requirements of General Order dated April 3, 2008 as amended. Order No. T-37748 finds Nola Moving, LLC guilty; orders that Nola Moving pay a \$2,000 fine and \$25 citation fee; orders that Nola Moving pay all fines and fees within 30 days of the Order, noting that with Order No. T-37748 and Order No. T-37118, Nola Moving owes fines totaling \$3,000 and fees totaling \$50; and, orders that Nola Moving shall either cease all advertising for moving household goods intrastate and provide proof of such to the Commission, or obtain Commission authority to operate as an intrastate household goods mover within 30 days of the Order.

**ORDER NO. T-37772 - 4/30/2026** - Louisiana Public Service Commission vs. All My Sons Moving & Storage of Baton Rouge, LLC. In re: Alleged violation of Louisiana Revised Statute 45:168 and General Order dated July 01, 1921 as amended by exceeding rates as outlined in the company's tariff dated October 11, 2017, while operating under Common Carrier Certificate No. 7508-A allegedly having occurred on or about June 27, 2025. Order No. T-37772 finds All My Sons Moving & Storage of Baton Rouge, LLC guilty and requires All My Sons to pay a \$1000 fine and a \$25 citation fee within 30 days of the Order. Order No. T-37772 documents the Commission's vote at the April 15, 2026 Business and Executive Session adopting the ALJ Recommendation issued on March 26, 2026.
