CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY  
AS A COMMON CARRIER OF SPECIAL COMMODITIES OVER IRREGULAR ROUTES

(Cancels Certificate No. 6014-A)

A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY IS HEREBY GRANTED TO HUBERT SAVOY TRUCKING, INC. whose office or place of business is at RAYNE, LOUISIANA authorizing operations in Louisiana intrastate commerce as a COMMON CARRIER OF SPECIAL COMMODITIES OVER IRREGULAR ROUTES by motor, handling the following described commodities, in territories described:

1. Transportation of liquid products, including mud, acids, disposal fluid, salt water, fresh water, drilling fluids and other liquid products, but excluding such products as oil, gasoline, diesel fuel, ammonia, liquid asbestos or similar products or by-products, in vacuum trucks or trailers, only, to and from all points and places within a one hundred fifty (150) mile radius of Rayne, Louisiana.

Restricted against any transfer or lease of the certificate to any company or person outside the immediate family of Hubert Savoy. If any lease or transfer application is filed, the certificate shall be cancelled.

2. Transportation of crude oil, with or without water, processed crude oil in vacuum trucks and trailers to and from all points and places within a One Hundred Fifty (150) mile radius of Rayne, Louisiana.

Certificate owner shall not own or operate from any terminal outside of Rayne, Louisiana.

Certificate owner shall not apply for any amendment to this certificate before January 1, 1997.

Certificate owner shall be restricted to the use of company owned vehicular units.

(Paragraph 1 reissued pursuant to Order No. T-18756 (Corrected), dated July 25, 1991, and Paragraph 2 reissued pursuant to Order No. T-18756-B, dated May 19, 1992 to amend certificate. Except for cause beyond control, non-operation of a certificate for a period of six (6) months could lead to its cancellation, citing La. R. S. 45:166, Paragraphs B and C.)

Said: HUBERT SAVOY TRUCKING, INC. shall perform such operations under tariffs now, or hereafter, filed with the Commission and, in compliance with all laws and rules and regulations of the Commission bearing thereon.
