***Re: Docket No. S-37738, Lafourche Telephone Company, LLC and Onvoy, LLC., In re: Request for approval of an Interconnection Agreement pursuant to Section 251 and 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.***

Dear Ms. Britton,

Pursuant to Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the "Act"), the Louisiana Public Service Commission ("Commission") notifies Lafourche Telephone Company, LLC ("Lafourche") and Onvoy, LLC ("Onvoy") of the following:

1. On September 22, 2025, the Commission received an executed Interconnection Agreement by and between Lafourche and Onvoy pursuant to the Act seeking the Commission publish notice of the Agreement in the Commission's Official Bulletin. The request was published in the Commission's Official Bulletin dated September 26, 2025 for a twenty-five-day intervention period.
2. The intervention period has lapsed with no intervention or opposition being received by the Commission.
3. Section 252(e) of the Act requires that the Commission approve or reject an Interconnection Agreement with ninety (90) days of its submission.

4. Pursuant to Section 252(e):

- a. The Commission has not found that the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; and
- b. The Commission has not found that the agreement is inconsistent with the public interest, convenience, or necessity.

Accordingly, request for approval of an amendment to the interconnection agreement pursuant to Sections 251 and 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1006 between Lafourche Telephone Company, LLC and Onvoy, LLC **is deemed approved**. This letter closes the docket and no further action will be taken.
