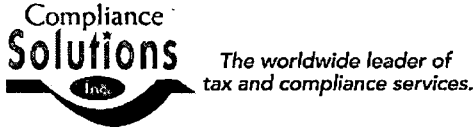

VII.

Petitioner is financially prepared to provide the services proposed in its tariff, as evidenced by its financial statements, a copy of which is attached in a separately sealed envelope marked "CONFIDENTIAL," as **Exhibit D**.

VIII.

Mobile 13, Inc. will resell prepaid wireless telecommunications services through established carriers such as Boom Mobile. Upon approval, Mobile 13, Inc. intends to provide wireless services, including mobile phone services and ancillary service features, such as call waiting and Caller Id. Its services will be available twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week to customers within the geographic boundaries of the State of Louisiana.

IX.

Petitioner possesses the experience to support the services to be offered as set forth in the resumes of its key management personnel, which are attached hereto as **Exhibit E**.

X.

Petitioner is also in the process of applying for authority to operate a Commercial Mobile radio Service Provider ("CMRS") in all 50 states and Puerto Rico. No state has denied any requested authority.

Mobile 13, Inc. submits the following arguments to demonstrate that the public interest will be served by the approval of this Petition:

Grant of this petition will further the public interest by expanding the availability of competitive telecommunications services in the state. In addition, intrastate offering of these services is in the public interest because the services will provide customers with access to new technologies and service choices and can permit customers to achieve increased efficiencies and cost savings. Petitioner's entry into the intrastate wireless telecommunications services market thereby will enhance the telecommunications infrastructure in the state and will facilitate economic development.

In particular, the public will benefit directly through the use of the competitive services to be offered by petitioner, and indirectly because the presence of petitioner in this market will increase the incentives for other wireless providers to operate more efficiently, offer more innovative services, reduce their prices, and improve their quality of service.

Wherefore, Petitioner requests that the Commission grant its petition for authority to Operate as a Reseller of Commercial Mobile Radio Services within the State of Louisiana.


