NOW BEFORE THE COMMISSION, through undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 10 of the Louisiana Public Service Commission ("Commission" or "LPSC") Rules of Practices and Procedures, comes Cleco Power LLC ("Cleco"), and files this Notice of Intervention, and requests to be made a party to this proceeding and placed on the service list, and, with respect, represents as follows:

1.

Cleco operates as an electric public utility within the State of Louisiana, with its principal offices located at 2030 Donahue Ferry Road, Pineville, Louisiana 71360.

2.

Cleco is a public utility owning and operating generation, transmission and distribution facilities in Louisiana.

3.

This proceeding was initiated by the Commission to consider possible modifications to the Commission's current net metering rules contained in LPSC General Order No. R-31417, dated July 26, 2013. The Commission published notice of this docket in Official Bulletin #1105, dated January 1, 2016. Interventions and comments are due on or before January 21, 2016. Cleco's notice of intervention is therefore timely.

4.

On December 29, 2015, the LPSC Staff issued for comment *Proposed Modifications to the Commission's Current Net Metering Rules*. Cleco plans and reserves its right to file comments on or before January 21, 2016 in response to the Staff's Proposed Modifications to the Commission's current net metering rules.

5.

As an LPSC-regulated electric public utility that provides electric service to customers that have net metering facilities, Cleco has an interest in this proceeding. In addition, Cleco was an active party to the LPSC's prior net metering rulemaking proceeding, Docket No. R-31417. Cleco therefore wishes to participate in this docket as an intervenor.


